Zawadi, meaning "Gift" is standing at home in Nairobi, Kenya.

How fast is she moving?

NB: The radius of the Earth is about 6000KM.

NB: The distance to the Sun is about 150 Million KM



My Friend Zawadi





Zawadi lives in Nairobi which is close to the equator.

She is standing still so not moving relative to the Earth.

But if you did the sums:

About 1,714 Kilometers per hour because the Earth is rotating.

About 107,000 Kilometers per hour round the Sun.

Roald Amundsen has just planted the Norwegian flag.

It is 14 December 1911.

What is his speed due to the Earth's rotation.





Roald Amundsen

He was at the South Pole so he was turning round at 15° per hour but otherwise not moving due to the Earth's rotation.
